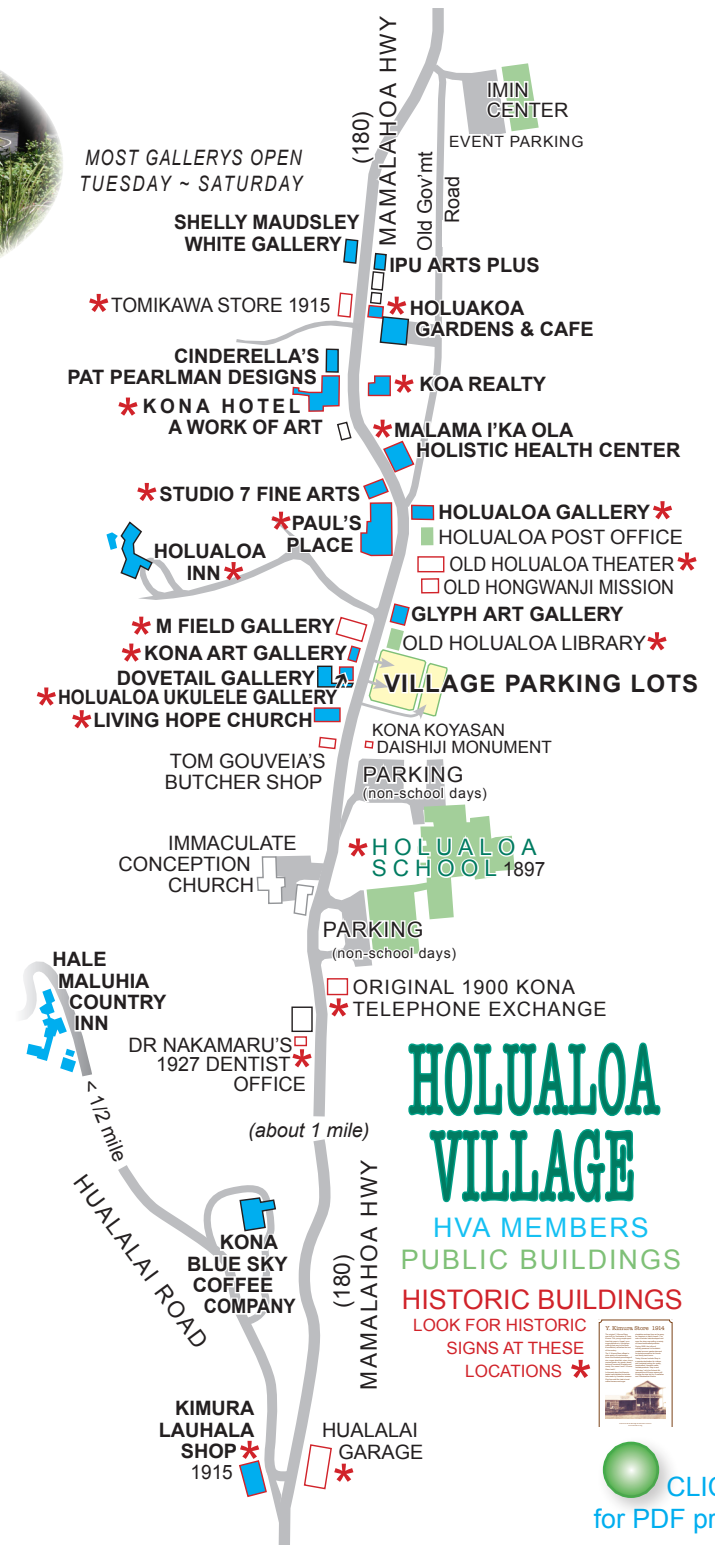


The historic village of Holualoa is nestled on the western side of Mt. Hualalai, about 1,300 above Kailua Kona, where cool air, lush foliage and abundant coffee farms await you.

A leisurely three mile, 15 minute, drive up scenic and curvey Hualalai Road from Queen Ka'ahumanu Hwy will end at Mamalahoa Hwy (180) and the Kimura Lauhala Shop. Then head north, where art studios and local shops now occupy over two dozen historic buildings from Hawaii's past.

Coming in from the upper road (Mamalahoa 190) is a 5 mile drive south on 180, a slow paced trip through Kona coffee farms into a relaxed upcountry lifestyle.
