

Ichishita Garage 1945



After the Second World War a garage was needed for the Ichishita Laundry next door. After the family moved the business to Kailua it was enclosed and used for storage until the Country Frame Shop took it over in the 1980s.

In the late 1990s Dahlia's Flower Shop brought color and life to the old building and also added the street side window. Next came Hale Kamana, a hui of local woodworkers, and an actual doorway for the old garage.

In 2005 the building was further improved to become the Kona Art Gallery you see today.
